AEE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

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PURPOSE

The AEE Foundation Scholarship program was established to encourage qualified practitioners in energy engineering, energy management, and sustainability by awarding scholarships to further education in the field. The Foundation has raised a total of over \$1,000,000 in funds to deserving and outstanding students.

FUNDING

The Scholarship Program is funded by contributions from AEE chapters, members, corporations, and individuals.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships shall be available to undergraduate and graduate degree candidates who are enrolled in engineering/sustainability programs at accredited colleges or universities.

Scholarship funds are to be used for courses directly related to those programs of study.

Candidates are nominated by the Chapter. The Chapter's Scholarship Committee initially screens the candidate for eligibility, need, and qualifications. Chapters can nominate up to 6 students per year max.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Call for Scholarship Nominations is made January 1. The Chapter should complete and submit the following forms to the current AEE-International Scholarship Chair no later than May 1:

- ❖ Student application
- ❖ Personal recommendation from a faculty member

- ❖ Student's current transcript (Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.)
- ❖ Statement of 100 to 300 words from student: "Why I wish to study in fields such as energy engineering, energy management, and/or sustainability?"
- ❖ Chapter nominations for general scholarships typically are in the amount of \$1,000; Named scholarships are different amounts (depending on the donor(s) instructions) and will be always an Albert Thumann Scholarship for \$4,000 to the top ranked applicant.

Recommendations for scholarships may be made only through AEE chapters, as shown above, with one exception: nominations will be accepted directly to FAEE from eligible applicants in areas where no AEE chapter exists.

All students must fit eligibility requirements for the academic year in which the scholarship was applicable.

Announcement of Scholarship Recipients is made via online (Foundation's Website) August 1.

CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

Chapters that wish to conduct their own scholarship programs should be aware that for donations to be tax deductible, they **must** be made to the AEE Foundation, not AEE or an AEE chapter. (AEE is a 501(c)(6) nonprofit organization, but only the AEE Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization.) **Restricted Scholarships:** Chapters may fund for their own scholarship program that has to be submitted to the Foundation along with instructions as to disbursement (the amount, the student, and the school), student application and current transcript (Unofficial transcripts are acceptable). The Foundation will then issue checks which will be sent to the Chapter for presentation, or directly to the recipients if instructed. Restricted scholarships are **not** subject to the FAEE Scholarship main deadline (May 1st)
