Who are Certified Demand-Side Managers?

- Are you an Energy Utility Professional that plans, manages, administers, or supports demand-side management (DSM) or demand response (DR) programs?
- Are you an energy-efficiency consultant that proposes DSM or DR projects to utilities or local, state, and federal government clients?
- Are you involved in the process of deciding which energy procurement, energy utilization, and energy cost reduction projects get approved?

A Certified Demand-Side Manager (CDSMTM) is an individual who plans, manages, administers, executes, or supports demand-side management (DSM), load management (LM) or demand response (DR) programs. The CDSM proposes DSM, LM or DR strategies, technologies or projects to utilities or local, state, and federal government clients as well as end use customers. The CDSM is involved in the process of monitoring, evaluating, and deciding which energy procurement, energy utilization, and energy cost reduction projects get approved or modified. This includes the use of a range of energy principles to demonstrate the impact on utility and customer costs, resiliency, capacity, reliability, and project financials. The CDSM understands how DSM, LM and DR program frameworks are viewed by customers, utilities, and communities. The CDSM also understands the implications of energy programs and how they align with organizational goals & expectations.







What does the Certified Demand Side Manager (CDSM[™]) Certification Program offer?

This program helps educate and qualify individuals involved in the value and impact of energy improvement projects on business. By obtaining the CDSM certification, candidates gain industry and peer recognition by demonstrating their understanding of core principles, practices, and technologies related to energy management and efficiency. The program raises the professional standards, both technical and ethical, of those engaged in this specialized, but growing industry sector.

What is the bottom line for me or my company?

Gaining a wide-reaching and industry-recognized certification is always a personal and financial investment. Individuals report career improvements in the form of salary and responsibility increases. The certification shows individuals hold a fundamental understanding of the profession and a commitment to the highest standards of quality. Companies, organizations, and consultants with a CDSM on-staff often see a higher affinity with their customers because CDSMs understand their customer's requirements and are a trusted source for DSM and DR related matters.

What functional areas does the CDSM™ Certification Program cover?

The certification program requires fundamental knowledge across several core principles and practices specific to demand-side management. These include:

- History of Demand Side Management (DSM), Demand
 Response (DR), and Load Management (LM)
- Planning and Evaluating DSM, DR, and LM
- Designing DSM, DR, and LM Programs
- Implementing DSM, DR, and LM Programs
- Managing DSM, DR, and LM Programs
- Verification & Analysis of DSM, DR, and LM Programs
- Future DSM, DR, and LM Programs

How do I become eligible for AEE's CDSM™ certification?

Every certification program offered by AEE is defined by strict standards to ensure the program maintains it's industry-wide recognition and credibility. To that end, AEE stipulates three criteria that all CDSM candidates must meet. Firstly, applicants must have relevant experience or educational credentials (see below). Secondly, candidates must undergo a defined training program that aligns with the fundamental knowledge base of the program, and the principles and practices of the industry as a whole. Thirdly, candidates must pass the associated exam to demonstrate their technical knowledge, proficiency, and abilities in the area of

Experience & Education

Applicants must meet one of the following eligibility criteria:

- Hold a 4-year degree OR Professional Engineer (PE) OR Registered Architect (RA) and 2+ years related* work experience.
- Hold a 4-year unrelated Bachelor's degree and 3+ years related* work experience.
- Hold a 2-year associate degree and 5+ years related* work experience.
- Have 10+ years related* work experience
- Be a current Certified Energy Manager (CEM®) OR Business Energy Professional (BEP®) OR Certified Energy Procurement Professional (CEP®).
- *Related degree in energy management, business, marketing, finance, engineering, or architecture and related experience in demand side management programs or work related to supporting demand-side management.
